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ARKANSAS STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION OPENS BIDS FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN BENTON COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (5-20) -- The Arkansas State Highway Commission has opened bids for improvements to a roadway in Benton County, according to Commissioner Dick Trammel of Rogers.

The purpose of the project is to resurface approximately five miles of Highway 412 near Siloam Springs. APAC-Arkansas, Inc. of Fayetteville, Arkansas, was awarded the contract at \$2,205,512.14.

“This resurfacing project will begin at Siloam Springs and continue eastward,” stated Trammel.

Trammel said work could begin on the project in two to four weeks, weather permitting. Completion is expected by September 14, 2009.

The project is being funded with money provided by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA). The Act provided Arkansas with \$351 million in federal stimulus funds for roadway and bridge improvements throughout the state.
