### **ARKANSAS STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION OPENS BIDS FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN POINSETT COUNTY**

**LITTLE ROCK (5-20)** -- The Arkansas State Highway Commission has opened bids for improvements to a roadway in Poinsett County, according to Commissioner John Ed Regenold of Armorel.

The purpose of the project is to resurface approximately two miles of Highway 63, west of Trumann. Atlas Asphalt, Inc. of Jonesboro, Arkansas, was awarded the contract at \$658,857.50.

“This resurfacing project will begin at the Craighead County Line and extend southward to Highway 69,” stated Regenold.

Regenold said work could begin on the project in two to four weeks, weather permitting. Completion is expected by September 14, 2009.

The project is being funded with money provided by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA). The Act provided Arkansas with \$351 million in federal stimulus funds for roadway and bridge improvements throughout the state.
