Improvements Require an Overnight Lane Closure on New Hope Road in Benton County

BENTON COUNTY (1-17) – Construction on New Hope Road requires an overnight, alternating lane closure, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The lane closure will begin **Wednesday**, **January 18**, and continue through **Thursday**, **January 19**, weather permitting. The closure will alternate between the inside eastbound and inside westbound lane from 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Traffic will be controlled using signage, traffic drums, and flaggers.

This project (Job CA0901) is part of AHTD's Connecting Arkansas Program and includes widening 5 miles of I-49 to three lanes in each direction. The work extends from Highway 264 in Lowell to New Hope Road in Rogers, and it is expected to complete in late 2017.
